

**Memorial CT1WW**



**1. Date and Time.**

The “**Memorial CT1WW**” contest, organized by Tertúlia Radioamadorística Douricense, will take place between **14h00 UTC of Saturday April 24** and **14h00 UTC of Sunday April 25 2010**.

**2. Type of competition.**

This is a **international** contest, all legal amateur radio stations are invited and encouraged to participate.

**3. Categories and sub-categories.**

a) Categories:

- 1) Fixed (FIXA)
- 2) Portable (PORTÁTIL )
- 3) Multi-operator (MULTIOPERADORA)
- 4) Check-log (CONTROLO)

b) All contesters (except for Check-log category) will be scored in the following **sub-categories**:

- 1) FM
- 2) SSB/CW
- 3) MIXED (FM+SSB/CW)

c) All contesters must choose only is **category, mandatory** written in the *log*. The **sub-category** will be automatically assigned based on QSO modes used.

d) Check-log category (CONTROLO) gives points only, not being classified or having any prize, trophy or certificate.

**4. Bands.**

a) The bands used will be the following, in the segments authorized by the national authorities and according to the IARU recommendations.

- b) 6m
- c) 2m
- d) 70cm
- e) 23cm

**5. Modes.**

The following modes are allowed, in the band segments recommended by IARU:

- a) CW
- b) FM
- c) SSB

## 6. QSO.

Only direct contacts are valid. Contacts via EME, meteor-scatter, satellites, repeaters, VOIP systems, etc, as well as contacts via any digital system are INVALID.

## 7. Exchange.

The stations must exchange: **RS(T)**, **sequential number** (starting in 001 by band) and **WW Locator** (ex.: IN61XX).

## 8. Call.

CQ concurso Memorial CT1WW or CQ CT1WW Memorial contest.

## 9. Points.

One point per kilometer based on stations *WW locator*.

## 10. Multipliers.

Different *locator* contacted during the contest.

- a) *Locator*, is the 4 initial digits of *WW locator* (IN61, IM58, etc).
- b) The multipliers counts only **once** per **band**.

## 11. Limitations.

Participants during the contest are limited to:

- a) Participate from one *locator* only.
- b) Participate in one category only.
- c) Contact each station once per band only.

## 12. Log.

*Logs* will be accepted in the electronic format EDI – *Electronic Data Interchange format for contests in Region1 above 30MHz ONLY*. No other format is accepted.

- a) The QTR, mandatory in *log*, must be in UTC.
- b) Each contact must include the **mode** (CW;FM;SSB).
- c) The *log(s)* files must be sent, as attachment, to: [log@trd.qrmzero.com](mailto:log@trd.qrmzero.com).
- d) The email, containing the *log*, should have as subject “**LOG CT1XXX**” (being CT1XXX the call sign used in the contest).
- e) Deadline for *log* submissions: **02/05/2010( 02/May/2010) at 24:00 UTC**
- f) All *log* received after the deadline will be ignored.
- g) The *log* reception, will be confirmed via email.

### 13. Correction criteria.

Apart from other, the correction criteria are:

- a) All contacts **must be verifiable** via the reception of both stations log.
- b) The **discrepancy of any of the contact parameters** makes the contact invalid.
- c) An exception to the previous point is the QTR, where a 5 (five) minutes maximum difference is accepted.
- d) The score is obtained as follow: sum of QSO points X sum of multipliers. [ex: CT1XXX made contacts in a total of 1234 Km having 5 multipliers; his score will be 6170 (1234 X 5)]

### 14. Classifications.

Stations will be classified:

- a) **General** – Sum of scores obtained in every band operated, regardless of entry category.
- b) **Band** – Score obtained in each band, regardless of entry category.
- c) **Category** – Score obtained in each band and entry category.
- d) **Sub-category** – Score obtained in each band, category and sub-category (according to point 3, sub-point a) e b). (ex: 2m Fixed FM; 70cm Portable SSB/CW; 23cm Multi-operator Mixed, etc)

### 15. Prizes.

- a) Trophy's to:
  - 1) **Contest champion** – First classified in **general** classification.
  - 2) **Champion by band** – First classified in each **band** classifications.
  - 3) **Best non Portuguese station** – First foreign station – operating outside Portuguese territory, classified in **general** classification.
- b) None of the previous trophies are cumulative. If a contester have right to more than one trophy, will receive only the first, according to the following trophy priority list; the other(s) trophy(s) will be attributed to the contestants classified next.
  - 1) Trophy priority list:
    - a) general
    - b) 23cm band
    - c) 70cm band
    - d) 2m band
    - e) 6m band
- c) **Other prizes** will be distributed according to the list published in <http://trd.qrmzero.com> .
- d) Certificates will be issued to all participant stations, mentioning the classification per band / category / sub-category.
  - 1) In the case of multi-operator stations a certificate will be issued to every operator, if all personal call signs are mentioned in *log*.

## 16. Disqualifications.

Contesters are disqualified if:

- a) Intentionally transmits incorrect data to other participants or the organization..
- b) Unsportsmanlike conduct.
- c) Violation of amateur radio regulations in the country of the contestant.
- d) Violation of the rules of the contest.

## 17. Classification lists.

Will be published at <http://trd.qrmzero.com> no later than 15 days after the log submission deadline.

- a) From the moment of classification lists are published, in the web page mentioned above, a 5 day period is granted for complaints. Complaints should be sent via the email: [reclama@trd.qrmzero.com](mailto:reclama@trd.qrmzero.com) .
- b) All complaints will be published, along with the organization decisions.
- c) Finished the complaints period and analysis, organization decisions will be final, and final results published.

## 18. General provisions.

- a) Participation in this contest implies the full knowledge and acceptance of these regulations.
- b) Any omissions will be decided by the organization, taking into account the spirit of the contest.
- c) The publication of provisional classification lists and definitive classification will be notified individually, by email, to all participants.
- d) This contest gives points for the Portuguese championship [Campeonato de Portugal 2010 VHF – UHF](#). In the championship bands all stations will be re-classified (integrating the multi-operator stations in the categories fixed or portable according to the radio amateur regulation - CT1XXX – fixed; CT1XXX/p – portable).
- e) The awards ceremony date will be published later.
